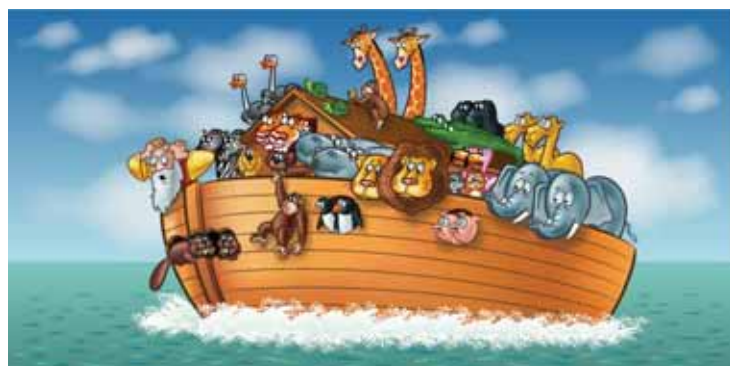

This week at the Chandler Jewish Playgroup we learned all about the story of Noah and the Teiva! Noah rounded all of the animals up one by one, so that each species would be saved on the Teiva (ark) during the flood- which lasted for 40 days! We made our very own 'flood' water bottles so we could learn about what it must have been like for the boat to be floating in the water. We put 2 different beads in the water bottle, one sunk and one floated just like the Teiva! Noah made the Teiva with 3 stories, each one was meant for a different use. The top was for the people, Noah and his family. The middle was for all of the animals! It must have been a zoo! (No pun intended ☺) The bottom was for all of the stinky garbage- with that many animals there must have been a lot!



We learned about so many different types of animals this week, cows, chickens, elephants, ducks, and other animals that were also on the Teiva. Did you know that baby elephants are called calves just like baby cows? Or that baby chickens use a special tooth to break out of their egg? It is so cool to learn all of these interesting animals facts!

We did an animal hunt, our Morahs threw pictures of animals all over the classroom and we had to run around and find them all! Then we sorted them into piles and sorted which was kosher or not. Did you know giraffes are kosher?! Come by and check our the Teiva we made and decorated on our bulletin board!

Speaking of Cows... We learned all about the letter C this week! Carrots and cucumber start with a C. It is very tricky because celery and circle also starts with C. And Chaya too! We painted with carrots and celery- it was very funny to paint with vegetables! Our Hebrew letter of the week was Bais. Bais has a belly button! Belly Button also starts with the Bais sound- learning our letters are so much fun!
